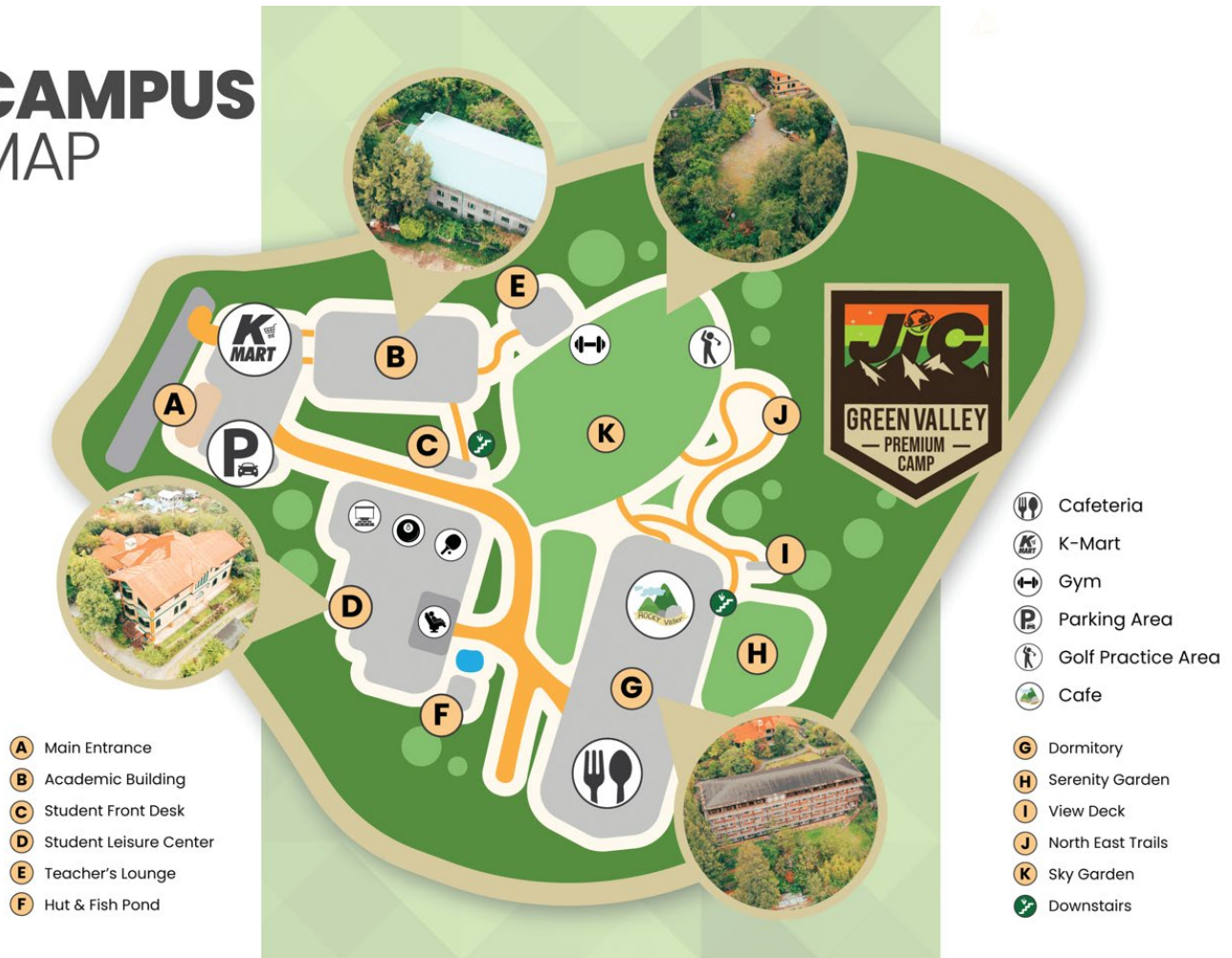

- 1 class consists of 45-minutes class and 5-minutes break.
- Textbooks are distributed collectively according to the program and level of the student. (non-refundable)
 - If the total attendance rate is less than 90%, certificate of completion and report cards will not be issued.
- After the start of class, tardiness will be marked after 5-minutes of the beginning of the class, but absences will be marked after 10-minutes. (No make-up classes will be given)
 - In an event of a cancellation due to the absence of a teacher, a substitute teacher will be assigned first, or a make-up class will be given depending on the availability of the student and teacher.
- If you plan to be absent, you must fill out an absence form and submit it to the office before your class. If your reason of absence/s is deemed unreasonable, your absence will be unauthorized.

Changing of Schedule

1. The official changing of schedule is every 2-weeks.
 2. Submit your application for change by 11:00 am on Thursday. (During the Monthly Test week, submission should be given by 11:00 am on a Wednesday)
 3. Complete the Change Application Form and consultation with the person in charge.
 4. After consultation with the person in charge, classes will be monitored. (There will be a class observer to monitor the class)
 5. If there is no improvement after giving feedbacks, the teacher will be changed. (Changes in the schedule will apply on the next Monday)
- A teacher cannot conduct more than 2 classes per student. (Only one class is available depending on the teacher and subject: grammar, writing, group classes, etc.)
 - Class schedule timetable cannot be selected by the students and will be assigned by the Head Teacher or person in charge after a consultation.
 - Classes can be changed depending on the program and subject in progress.
 - If multiple students' class change request (schedule, time) overlap, the priority requests will be decided after computing their attendance and penalties for the past 2 weeks.

Vocabulary Test

- Vocabulary Tests are mandatory for Sparta course students from Monday to Friday. (Except on holidays)
- Timetables are subject to change. Tardiness and cheating are considered a violation of our rules and regulation. Penalties will be applied.
- Vocabulary test levels may be changed every 2 weeks.
- 25 words are given on their first day and 25 new words will be added on the next day. A total of 50 questions are given per day.
- For every incorrect answer, the student must write the vocabulary 10 times and submit these words to the person in charge

Night Study (20:00 – 22:00)

- It is mandatory to stay in your designated seat. Tardiness and absences are considered as a violation. Penalties shall be applied.
- 2 or more students are not allowed inside the self-study designated rooms. Bringing in food is also prohibited.
- If recording is required, a designated place will be given.
- Classrooms except for group classrooms are available for self-study after the mandatory night study hours. (Remember to turn the lights off after you finish studying)
- If you need to leave your seat (to go to the toilet or your accommodation, etc.), you must fill out the logbook after getting permission from the person in charge. (Student is allowed up to 10 minutes only)
- You may request to change seats from the person in charge.

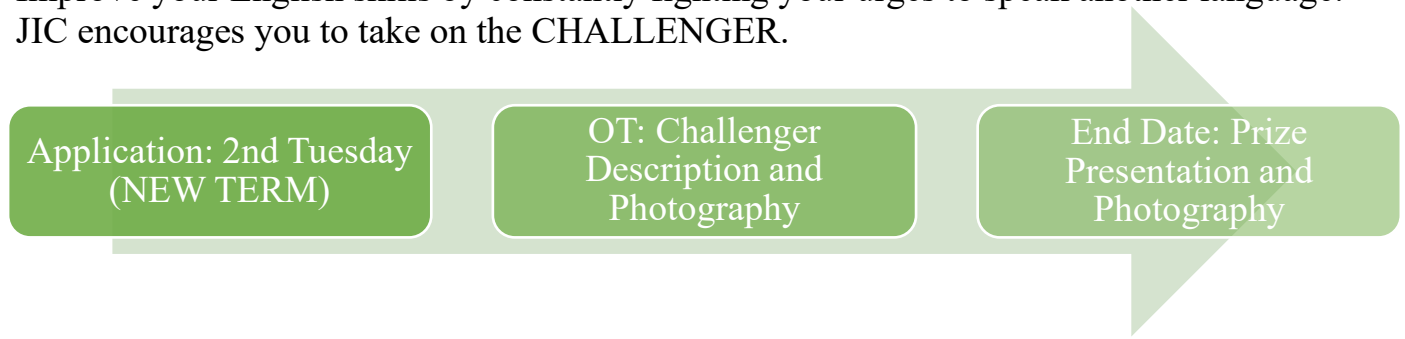
- If you are absent (including sick leave) after submitting your absence form, the student will have a mandatory weekend study.
- Weekend supplementary study is conducted at a set time in a designated classroom.
- Classrooms are open 24 hours a day (excluding group classrooms) so it is essential to turn the lights off when not using, and to clean after use.

Precautions when using the Dormitory:

- Changing of dormitory room is allowed and may be applied in the office if there are available rooms (additional fee will apply if needed; no refunds when downgrading a room type)
- Entering other rooms are prohibited.
- For damages or inconvenience from the rooms, please fill out a form and submit it to the office.
- Items in the dormitory that are damaged and incurred by the student will be charged on a certain fee depending on the severity of the damage.
- Dormitory Check-in: Sunday (Academic schedule starts on a Monday. Sunday arrivals are recommended.
- Dormitory Check-out: Saturday before 1pm (Additional payments will be incurred for students who will check-out on a later time or date. This will be allowed depending on the availability of rooms. Extra night's price is ₱2,000)

(No laundry services in case of time violation) • Buy laundry basket at the cafeteria for 55 pesos. • Laundry service uses regular laundry and drying products (regular fabric softener) to wash. • You can pick your laundry up at the laundry area from 6pm to 8pm. • Laundry is 1,000 pesos per term. • Not Accepted: High-quality and special-material clothes, shoes, bags, hats, etc. (Should you choose to avail of the service, the company is not responsible for color change, fastness of color, shrinkage or damage to high quality or special-material items.) • The academy is not responsible for laundry color change, bleaching, or damage caused by the use of washing machine and dryers. • The academy is not responsible for missing items. If found, the item will be returned to the student promptly. If an item is not yours, please return it to the laundry area. • Bed sheets and blankets are replaced once a month. (Request for replacements will be accepted within 1 month. If a student requests to replace the bedsheets and blankets more than once in a month, an additional fee of P300 will be applied.) • Washing schedule may change due to local conditions such as power outages or lack of water supply. 	

3. Cleaning Services

- You can apply for cleaning up to twice a week (Monday to Friday).
- Apply according to the cleaning schedule form announced every Friday. (This cleaning schedule is for the next week.)
- When applying for cleaning, keep in mind that one room member should be free at that time and present when the room is being cleaned.
- The room will not be cleaned if there is no one present in the room.
- Cleaning services includes cleaning of rooms, floor, and toilet (empty trash can).
- Cleaning services do not include cleaning of desks and beddings (bed).
- Your belongings and valuables must be taken care of individually, and if you lose them, you are responsible.

5. Travel and Overnight

- You must follow the travel and overnight stay rules for each course. (Travelling is allowed from 6 am)
 - You can travel and stay out from Friday night (10PM), weekends and public holidays, and you must return to the academy by 10:00 PM on the last day of the holiday or weekends (Sunday).
 - For travel and overnight stays, travel plans must be submitted the day before the start of the trip.
 - If you do not submit a travel plan or request a travel plan on the designated day, it will not be allowed (You will be violating the rules if you do not return home within curfew time.)
 - Friday-Sunday trips and overnight stay outs are possible but must submit a Travel Plan. On the last day of the holiday (or Sunday), students must return to the academy by 10:00 PM.

- Cancellation of travel plan: If you cancel your travel or overnight stay plan, you can return to the academy by 1:00 am (Friday is 10PM). Upon request, depending on the judgment of the staff, access to the academy may be permitted, but it will be treated as a violation of curfew regulations.

- No travel plan submitted: Travel and overnight stays are prohibited and curfew times must be observed. In case of violation, fines and demerit points are accumulated, and you must enter the academy before 6 am. After 6 am, the rule of staying out without permission applies.

- During the training period, it is not possible to travel on weekdays, but it is possible to visit family and relatives after submitting proof.
